



Teacher Grant Program Frequently Asked Questions

Please note grants are limited to teachers that serve students in the Florida FPL service territory. (County is served by FPL)

Q. When will applications be accepted?

A. The application will be available on our website from August 15, 2014 until November 15, 2014.

Q. How do I submit application for grant?

A. Go online and complete application electronically at <http://www.fpl.com/community/learning/solarstations.shtml> (Keep a copy of your application)

Q. We are working on a project that needs \$10,000 in funding. Can we apply to have your foundation provide some of the money needed?

A. No, we only fund projects that can be completed using a grant from our program with a maximum of \$1,000 per project.

Q. I teach in Orlando, can I submit a grant application?

A. Please note grants are limited to teachers that work in school districts that receive their power from FPL.

Q. Who will review the grant applications?

A. Applications will be reviewed by the National Energy Education Development Project.

Q. When will the winners be announced?

A. Winners will be announced by mid-December and posted on our website at www.fpl.com/community/learning/solarstations.shtml. Winners will receive a letter with their check outlining their award.

Q. Will the grant check be made out to the teacher of school?

A. The check will go to the school with the specific purpose to benefit your classroom project.

Q. Do I need to submit a report after receiving my grant?

A. Yes, you will be required to complete a final report and submit to program manager Maureen Wilt by June 1, 2015.

Q. I received a grant from FPL in the past and have not submitted an end of project report, am I eligible to apply for a grant this year?

A. Teachers that have not submitted reports for previous grants will not be funded for future projects.
